

HAND HYGIENE USING VIONEXUS™

Wash...

when hands are visibly dirty, contaminated, or soiled.

- Before and after eating
- After using the restroom
- Before and after work shifts

Sanitize...

when hands are not visibly soiled.

BEFORE:

- Patient contact
- Donning sterile gloves prior to inserting a central intra-vascular catheter
- Inserting indwelling catheters and other invasive devices that do not require a surgical procedure
- Moving from a contaminated-body site to a clean-body site during patient care

AFTER:

- Contact with a patient's skin
- Contact with bodily fluids or excretions
- Contact with non-intact skin
- Contact with wound dressings
- Contact with inanimate objects, including medical equipment in the immediate vicinity of the patient
- Removing gloves

Use VioNexus Foaming Soap & Water for Washing



1. Apply generous amount of soap.
2. Rub hands together vigorously for at least 15-20 seconds.
3. Cover all hand surfaces.
4. Rinse. Avoid hot water.
5. Dry thoroughly with a disposable towel. Multiple-use cloth towels are not recommended.
6. Turn off faucet with same towel.

Use VioNexus No-Rinse Spray for Sanitizing



1. Tuck fingers in while receiving VioNexus to ensure total coverage over nails and cuticles.



5. Rub fingers of each hand in the palm of the opposite hand.



2. Rub hands together palm to palm.



6. Rub each thumb clasped in the opposite hand.



3. Rub between interlaced fingers.



7. Rub each wrist clasped in the opposite hand.



4. Rub back of each hand with the palm of the other hand.



8. Continue rubbing until hands are dry.
